Dear Field Day of the Past Arts & Crafts Vendors:

We want to thank all of you from the bottom of our hearts for participating in the 2021 Field Day of the Past. We were very pleased with the turnout from our vendors and the general public considering the amount of time and work we had to do to prepare the new site. We had approximately 15,000 people in attendance and are anticipating that more will join us in 2022.

Field Day of the Past 2022 will be held Sept. 16-18. Enclosed you will find a 2022 Arts and Crafts Application. For those who may have received an application at the 2021 show, please note there has been a change in the deadline for registering for 2022. **THE NEW DEADLINE FOR APPLYING FOR AN ARTS AND CRAFTS SPACE IS APRIL 1, 2022.**

Space rental remains the same at \$75 for a 15'x15' space, \$100 for a 20'x20' space, and \$125 for a 20'x30'. Vehicles will still be allowed only in 20'x20' or 20' x 30' spaces. For 2022, one ticket for each day will again be included in your arts and crafts registration. Parking passes will still be necessary to get onto and off the grounds. Please do not rent additional space for the express purpose of parking a vehicle.

Once we receive your application, you have been accepted unless we contact you to the contrary. We will limit the number of spaces sold for like items, i.e., pet accessories, makeup, cooking items, etc., so, if you are selling a popular product, register early. We already have vendors who have registered with us.

You will receive information on tickets, set up times, parking passes and your location in mid August/early September.
